Please see attached the SATs timetable for the week commencing Monday 11th May 2015. All of the assessments for levels 3-5 will take place during the mornings of that week. In the afternoon, some pupils will answer level 6 papers.

At the end of the school year you will be notified of your child's attainment as follows:

- Maths test level and Maths teacher assessment level
- Reading test level and Reading teacher assessment level
- English Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling test level
- Writing teacher assessment level (based on writing across the year)
- Science teacher assessment level (informed by tests and work in class)

All children **must** be in school by 8.45am so that we can begin promptly. However, we would like to invite the children to come into school from 8.30am onwards for breakfast. This will give them plenty of time to get themselves ready for the day, have breakfast, go to the toilet and chat with friends. Hopefully, this will lessen the anxiety that we know some of the children are feeling.

As we are sure you are all aware, the children have been working very hard in preparation for these assessments and each of them truly deserve to do well. If you have any questions please don't hesitate to come in and see us.

2015 Statutory Assessment Tests timetable

The levels 3-5 tests must be taken before the corresponding level 6 tests on the scheduled day. All pupils who are entered for a level 6 test must also complete the corresponding levels 3-5 test.

Monday 11 May	Levels 3-5 English reading test	60 minutes
	Level 6 English reading test	10 minutes reading time 50 minutes to complete the test
Tuesday 12 May	Levels 3-5 English grammar, punctuation and spelling test	Paper 1: short answer questions – 45 minutes Paper 2: spelling task – 15 minutes (not strictly timed)
Wednesday 13 May	Levels 3-5 Mental mathematics test	Allow approximately 20 minutes
	Levels 3-5 mathematics Paper 1 (Calculator not allowed)	45 minutes
	No level 6 tests are timetabled for this day	
Thursday 14 May	Levels 3-5 mathematics Paper 2 (Calculator not allowed)	45 minutes
	Level 6 mathematics Paper 1 (Calculator not allowed)	30 minutes
	Level 6 mathematics Paper 2 (Calculator allowed)	30 minutes

Some pupils may be able to take a test at a different time from the rest of the cohort, subject to strict criteria. Under no circumstances may a test be taken before the day specified in the statutory timetable.
